

GIRL DESERTED; MAN SOUGHT

Worth County Man Issues Warrant for
W. M. Jordan's Arrest.

SYLVESTER, Sept. 25.—A warrant charging W. M. Jordan with bigamy has just been sworn out here by W. H. Moree, of Worth county. About ten days ago Jordan, accompanied by Tom Floyd, came to the home of Mr. Moree, representing himself to be a Methodist preacher, and Jordan and the daughter of Moree were quietly married, Floyd performing the ceremony.

The father of the young lady began an investigation and learned that no marriage license had been issued for the couple, and since that time Jordan has disappeared, leaving the young lady at Albany, at which place they had been since the marriage.

A warrant for "Rev." Tom Floyd has also been sworn out by the father of the young lady, charging him with a misdemeanor in that he performed the marriage ceremony without a license.
